**REACH** - A European Community Regulation on chemicals and their safe use. The aim of REACH is to improve the protection of human health and the environment through the better and earlier identification of the intrinsic properties of chemical substances. The Regulation also calls for the progressive substitution of the most dangerous chemicals when suitable alternatives have been identified.

**RoHS** – An EU Directive aimed at restricting the use of six (6) substances in electrical equipment produced or imported into the European Community member countries.

**SVHC** - A European Chemicals Agency (ECHA) proposal of an initial 16 Substances of Very High Concern. Article 33(1) of the REACH Regulation states that manufacturers and importers of articles (products) are required to notify their customers of the presence of any Substances of Very High Concern (SVHC) in their products exceeding 0.1% by weight

**At this time, all parts supplied by MINOR RUBBER are in compliance with the Regulations or Directives stated above. None of the products we provide utilize substances / chemicals, as stated in these regulations, in either our processes or in the composition of the materials utilized in producing them. Further, the products Minor Rubber provides are such that none of the substances contained in our products are intended to be released under normal or reasonable conditions of use.**

Minor Rubber will continue to monitor the above Regulations for any changes that may involve our products in the future.
